

Art Exhibitions: Forest Hill Chase Community Space

Purpose:

- Provide a space for local artists to exhibit their work in an easily accessible location
- Provide an additional reason for people to come in to the Community Space
- Encourage local churches to take responsibility for a particular period of exhibiting time and showcase a number of artists from within their congregations
- Promote the space among the churches, providing an additional reason for people to come and visit (eg. to view the art of people within their congregations)

Note: WCC takes no responsibility for the artwork while it is being displayed at the Community Space

Requirements for exhibitors:

- Art needs to be ready to hang (wire on the back of the piece)
- Exhibitors to assist with hanging/displaying artwork in the Community Space at an agreed time.
- Exhibitors to provide photos of their work with artist contact information and pricing if item is for sale

Selling artwork:

Provision will be made for the sale of artwork, within a set of general principles and negotiated on a case by case basis.

Internal exhibitors (eg. existing, active volunteers)

- No requirement for volunteers to make a donation to WCC if they make a sale.

External exhibitors (eg. church congregation members - non vols, MS group/Chinese brush art)

- Suggest a donation of between 20-50% of the artwork price (to be negotiated prior to exhibition)

All sales will be negotiated directly between artist and purchaser - and then any donations made by the artist to Whitehorse Churches Care.
