CHECK THE CALENDAR

CHOOSE YOUR TIME

Select a time when you would like to pray between 28 Nov 6pm and 1 Dec 7pm. Create an account or simply select 'Proceed as a Guest'. If needed, adjust the duration and use the repeat options.

CHOOSE YOUR LOCATION

This is not a in-person prayer gathering. When your prayer time comes around, we invite you to pray in a location that suits you best, whether it be in the quiet of your lounge room, sitting in the park or walking the block with others.
